CSS Outlines property is used to apply color, style and width on extra border around an element.

There are four type of Outline property as below.

- 1. **outline**: It is used to set all the below three properties in a single statement.
- 2. **outline-color**: It is used to set the color of the outline.
- 3. **outline-style**: It is used to set the line style of the outline. The value of outline-style are dashed, dotted, double, groove, hidden, inset, none, outset, ridge, solid.
- 4. **outline-width**: It is used to set the width of the outline. There are three value like thin, medium, or thick.

## **Syntax:**

```
outline:dashed #333333 medium;
outline-color:#333333;
outline-style:double;
outline-width:thick;
```

## **Example:**

```

<body>
outline property with color, width and style.
outline-color property with color.
outline-style property is used to set double border.
outline-width property is used to set thick outline
```
