PHP array\_pop() Function is used to remove the last element of an array. The array\_pop() is a built-in function of PHP.

**Syntax :**

*array\_pop(array)*

**Parameter,**

*\$array* : Required It is type of array parameter.

**Return :** It returns array with removed last element. If **array** is empty, or is not an array, **NULL** will be returned.

Let's see below example to understand php array\_pop() Function in details.

**Example :**

echo "<br><br>Deleting last one element from an array.<br>";
$tutorials= array("PHP", "HTML", "JAVASCRIPT", "JAVA", "CSS");
array_pop($tutorials);
print_r($tutorials);
?>
```
