PHP mysqli_select_db() Function is used to choose database for the connection. Also You can select the default database using 4th parameter in mysqli connect() function.

PHP Version: PHP 5, PHP 7

Syntax for mysqli_select_db:

According to Procedural

mysqli select db(\$connection, \$database name);

According to Object oriented

\$mysqli -> select db(\$database name);

Parameter,

\$connection : Required. It is MySQL connection object which is return by mysqli_connect() function. *\$database name :* Required. It is database name.

Return values for mysqli_connect:

It returns TRUE on success and FALSE on failure.

Example for mysqli_connect:

Let's see below example to understand php mysqli_select_db() Function in details.
