

# WordPress - Delete Users

Deleting users in WordPress is a straightforward process. However, before you delete a user, it's important to understand that deleting a user removes their access to the site, but it does not delete the content they have created. Here's how you can delete users in WordPress:

## Delete Users:

### 2. Access the Users Section:

- In the left sidebar, find and click on "Users."

### 3. View All Users:
