- Choose your site's timezone. This setting is crucial for scheduling posts and ensuring that your site displays the correct time.

## 8. Date Format and Time Format:

- These settings allow you to choose how dates and times are displayed on your site. You can pick a predefined format or customize it using PHP date and time format codes.

## 9. Site Language:

- Choose the language in which you want WordPress to be displayed. This affects the language of the admin interface.

## 10. Site Icon:

- Also known as a favicon, the site icon is a small image that represents your site. It appears in the browser's address bar or tab when someone visits your site.

## 11. Save Changes:

- After making any adjustments, don't forget to click the "Save Changes" button to apply your modifications.
